St Agnes College (Autonomous) Mangaluru, India, is a premier Catholic Educational Institution founded on 2 July 1921 by a great visionary Mother Mary Aloysia, the Second Superior General of the Apostolic Carmel Congregation who was the first recipient of Kaiser-i-Hind Gold Medal of the First Class in 1929, a prestigious National Award by the then British Government of India, for her contribution in the field of Women's Education. St Agnes College was the first women's college on the West Coast of India and the first, under private management, in the whole country.

## Library

The Library and Information Centre, a knowledge and innovation hub, has computerized its services using Easylib Web 6.2A. It offers a diverse collection of books, magazines, journals, CDs, DVDs, and newspapers, along with access to e-books and e-journals via INFLIBNET-NLIST and J-Gate databases. The library ensures resource security with RFID technology, tracks users with eSSL Biometric Software, and provides plagiarism checks through DrillBit. Additional services include photocopying and ID Card generation. The library hosts exhibitions, workshops, seminars, competitions and annually celebrates Librarians' Day in August, honoring Dr. S. R. Ranganathan.

## *Eligibility Criteria for UG Programmes*

A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Examination Board in the State of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto by Mangalore University is eligible for admission to these Programmes.

### *Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)*

Candidate for the B.A. Degree Programme shall have passed the Pre-University Examination with any combination of subjects, or equivalent 12th standard examination of any other Board.

### *Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)*

Candidate for the B.Sc. Degree Programme shall have studied **Physics, Chemistry** and **Mathematics** in the Pre-University to take up any **Physical Science** Programme and **Chemistry, Botany** and **Zoology** or **Biology** to take up any **Biological Science** Programme.

Students opting **Statistics | Economics** Combination must have studied **Major Mathematics** in PUC or equivalent examination.

Candidates for the **BSc. Data Science Degree Programme** shall have studied **Science** in the Pre-University or equivalent 12th standard examination of any other Board.

### *Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)*

Students who have taken Commerce stream in PUC or equivalent 12th standard examination are eligible to apply for **B.Com. - General / B.Com. (BPS) [Business Process Services] Industry Integrated Programme offered through TCS / B.Com. with CMA (Certified Management Accountant) / B.Com. with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) / B.Com. Professional (CA) / B.Com. with Business Analytics/ B.Com. with Financial Technology (FINTECH) / B.Com. with Logistics & Supply Chain Management / B.Com. with Apprenticeship - Internship Embedded Degree Programme.**

Those who have taken Science stream in PUC or equivalent 12th standard examination are also eligible to apply for **B.Com. with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) / B.Com. Professional (CA).**

# Instructions for Online Application Submission

## Admission Guidelines

1. The application form should be filled online and submitted along with II PUC marks (Provisional or Final).
2. To fill the application form access Google Chrome/Microsoft Edge/Mozilla Firefox browsers.
3. For more than one admission please click on + Button on the Dashboard. You can add up to 5 students.  
Access the application form by choosing the applicant's name from student dashboard and then edit the form.
4. All the fields that are with an asterix symbol \* are to be filled mandatorily.
5. Name of the student must be as per SSLC/HSC/CBSE/ICSE marks card.
6. If provisional admission is made based on previous academic records, final admission will be done only after producing the qualifying examination marks card at the earliest.
7. The application form will be submitted only after paying Registration Fees.
8. If the candidate is not residing with the parents, a local guardian in Mangalore is a mandatory requirement.  
Please submit name, address and phone number of the local guardian.
9. Admission will take place as per the admission criteria and according to the availability of seats.
10. Please ensure that all the data entered is accurate before submitting the application.  
Application once submitted cannot be edited.
11. Before submitting the application, please read the Eligibility Criteria document provided on the dashboard for further instructions.
12. Please check all the details entered before you proceed for submission.
13. Spot admission for meritorious students will be done and the candidates will be required to pay the fees immediately on confirmation.
14. The candidate must be accompanied by one of the parents for admission. Please take note that a guardian can accompany the student only if both parents are deceased.
15. The candidate along with parents/guardian will attend the admission interview on a prescribed date.
16. Admission/Registration fees, once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.  
Admission fees should be paid within the prescribed date.

Ragging is an unpardonable injustice against the student community and students who indulge in this barbarian act will definitely be expelled from the institution and are also punishable by law. It is a criminal offence in India and can be punished under several sections of the **Indian Penal Code (IPC)**. **Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in this institution including in its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, cafeteria) located within the campus.**

Strict action including but not limited to criminal proceedings and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging would lie on the perpetrator and not on the victim. An offence of Ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent finding of the Anti-ragging Cell.

**Ragging is a crime which destroys the physical and emotional confidence in the students.** Ragging is completely banned in and around the college campus. The Anti-ragging Cell has been constituted in this college with the purpose of providing students with a comfortable and safe environment in the college campus. The main objective of the cell is to create awareness among students about what is ragging, which actions of the students turns out to be ragging and how it is **punishable under the Karnataka Education Act of 1983.**

The cell organizes meetings with students specially newcomers so that students feel comfortable to share their uncomfortable experiences in the campus if any.

The **Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act 2013** is a progressive law that aims to prevent and redress sexual harassment in the workplace. Preventing sexual harassment and creating a Grievance Redressal cell are essential for **creating a safe, respectful, and equitable workplace for all.**

The College offers suitable mechanisms to students for the resolution of their grievances as part of our ongoing efforts to ensure transparency in all the operations at different stages. **Sexual harassment of women in the workplace is a violation of human rights and dignity.** It affects not only the individual but also the organization and society at large.

The prevention of Sexual Harassment and Grievance Redressal Cell's goals are to foster an environment of safety and respect, to stop sexual harassment from happening, to aid victims, and to successfully handle complaints.

This committee will address all grievances relating to prevalent issues at the college level. Student concerns and complaints placed in the "**Suggestion Box**" are addressed by the management and the Grievance Redressal Cell.

### *Dress regulations*

- **Students will wear the uniform prescribed by the college.**
- **No other attire is permitted in the college premises throughout the working hours .**
- **No student will wear the head scarf inside the classroom.**
- **Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited inside the classroom.**

## *Assessment and Evaluation*

The duration of UG programmes shall extend over six semesters. The UG programme offered is structured with 154-155 credits for the various subjects taken for study, for the award of the Degree. The credits are allotted to every course of study based on number of hours per week. Students are required to participate compulsorily in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the college as part of the choice based credit system semester scheme. Each semester shall consist of 16 weeks of study. The Odd semester will commence in June/July and the Even semester will commence in November.

The continuous internal assessment(CIA) will have a weightage of 40% and the end semester NEP examination will have a weightage of 60%. However, under revised NEP (SEP), a weightage of 20% and the end semester examination will have a weightage of 80%. It is mandatory to appear for all the components of the CIA.



## *Attendance*

A candidate should have 75% attendance up to the end of the semester in each to qualify to answer the End Semester Examination. Students who do not have required attendance will not be allowed to answer the examination. They have to repeat the semester.

## Career Guidance & Placements

The Career Guidance Cell organizes various certificate courses to enhance the learning skills of students in various fields and also organizes guest lectures and campus placement drives.

### Career Oriented Programmes and Certificate Courses
